General Membership Meeting

April 28, 2026

Bruce called the meeting to order at 6:30p

There were 16 people in attendance.

President's Report (Bruce)

Bruce attended a Mercer rock swap event.

We have 10 yellow volunteer vests. Copycat is making them for the club. They'll read "volunteer".

There's now a Rock Shop in Boardwalk Shops in Minocqua. There's also a new one in Ironwood.

We need flat rocks for the rock painting at the annual gem and mineral show. We also need rocks for the kid's grab bags. We can also use rocks for the silent auction. Coordinate donations through Bruce.

Vice-President's Report (delivered by Bruce in Kim's absence)

The new bylaws were distributed. Mary moved to accept the new bylaws, seconded by Bill. Motion carried.

Field trips: We're scheduled to go to Saxon Harbor and Little Girl's Point this Thursday, April 30. Bruce has been up to the area already this year, reports there are people there every day looking for agates (among other things), but that he's had success looking.

There is a proposal for a field trip to the Adventure Mine including a tour and a stop at a rock shop in Ontanagan. Cost is expected to be between \$15 and \$20 per person. We will set a date in May, targeting June for the field trip.

Bruce proposed visiting a mine in Iron Mountain with stops at Kingsley North and rock shops in the area.
